WESTERN HONOREE sprinted clear, set the pace while kept out in the five path, drew off into the stretch and was not menaced while kept to the task. JUDGE SOPHIE outsprinted early, advanced six wide on the turn and closed willingly late. SCREAMIN STACEY seven wide into the turn when within striking distance, steadied near the quarter mile marker when JUDGE SOPHIE rallied past then made a late move. HELEN O reserved early, raced seven wide late on the turn and rallied belatedly. BUCK'N'PEARL forwardly placed along the inside, lacked the needed late bid. BACKWATER NIKKI outrun early, was eight wide entering the turn and was no threat. I'M A SHADEE LADY reserved off the inside, was no factor. INDIAN CHARMER close up early in the four path, faded. WYNN SEEKER closest to the early pace five wide, gave way.
