ATTRACTIVE RIDE drifted out at the start, raced within striking distance for a half, made a run four wide after five furlongs, angled out for the drive and drew clear late. DOOKIE DUCK steadied after breaking slowly to be outrun, angled out five wide near the quarter mile marker when rallying but lodged only a mild late bid. CHECKSANDBALANCES set the pace, saved ground on the second turn, battled into deep stretch and faltered. POUND THE ROCK swerved in at the start, raced close up after being straightened, challenged three wide on the second turn, held on well to the final furlong and tired. JUMP START NOW closest to the pace, challenged before a half, gained a short lead with a half mile to go, held on well to mid stretch and tired. MY FRIEND KEN unprepared after the start, stumbled when the winner drifted out at the start, steadied soon after then was outrun. A FOUL CLAIM BY THE RIDER OF DOOKIE DUCK AGAINST THE RIDER OF THE WINNER FOR INTERFERENCE AT THE START WAS NOT ALLOWED.
