BABYLON set the early pace three wide, moved in a path on the second turn and drew off in the stretch under steady urging. HIS SONG close up four wide, raced in the three path on the second turn and held on for the place. PERSONAL AGENDA drifted out at the start, was reserved five wide, moved up four wide before a half, stayed in that path on the second turn and tired in the drive. BUSTEM LOOSE forwardly placed off the inside, lacked a bid. RAJABLOU within striking distance three wide, gave way. KAYGOLD'S RUBY within reach four wide, moved out a path on the second turn and faded in the drive. CONTROL THE DICE was outrun. GRAY GALAXY forced the pace along the inside and faded.
