ROSES ROSES ROSES forwardly placed three wide, challenged on the second turn then drew clear in the drive under steady urging. DEVILLIOUS reserved off the inside, angled out entering the stretch but lodged only a mild bid to be up for the place. KERNITRE (GB) set the pace along the inside, held on well to midstretch and tired. IRONIC LADY closest to the pace off the inside, tired in the stretch. MISS THE MARK reserved along the inside, was no factor. BOURBON MINT pulled while reserved four wide on the first turn, made a mild gain on the second turn but faded in the stretch.
