OUR CAROL behind the leaders, launched her bid after a half and closed well on the outside to be clear. I REMEMBER YOU closest to the pace in the three path, lodged a mild bid for the place. WITCH TRADITION sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside but faltered late. OUR REVIVAL bumped on the backstretch, lodged a mild late bid. AUDIT EXCEPTION carried in on the backstretch, was in tight near the half mile marker then was no threat. BLUE DAZE steadied when in tight on the backstretch then was outrun. LEMON TWIST came in on the backstretch bothering inner rivals then was no threat.
