SIR JOCK set the pace off the inside, repulsed several rivals on the turn, drew clear into the stretch and lasted late. COVER BOY in tight at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, moved up four wide on the turn but lodged only a mild late bid. ROBBIE'S EXPRESS forwardly placed three wide, lacked a late bid. BOOYA SKEE DADDY outrun to the stretch, came five wide into the late and closed a late gap. SPARTAN KING within reach early, raced four wide midway through the turn and lacked a late bid. PICTURAL outrun to the stretch, showed late interest. HANCHO within reach three wide, lacked a rally. DESERT DOC in tight at the start, was outrun six wide. ESPRESSO JOE came in a bit at the start tightening up inner rivals, raced close up four wide and tired. WILD ALEX prompted the early pace, held on well to the three furlong marker and faded. MISTER MONSIEUR was no factor. MICHAELS PARK

forced the early pace off the inside and stopped.
