MEET BY THE RIVER sent to the lead near the rail, set the pace and drew off under steady urging. BROKEN TANGO behind the leaders three wide, lodged a mild bid to be second best while no threat to the winner. MR. LECHUGA forced the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. VARVATOS outrun to the stretch, rallied belatedly. THUNDER HIGHWAY within striking distance off the inside, tired. BOGO FREE within reach early along the rail, gave way. A SHOT AT LOVE steadied once in the turn behind rivals, swung out five wide just past the three furlong marker then was no factor. TIGER WOZ was outrun. COMMONWEALTH RUSH close up early, moved four wide with three furlongs to go and gave way.
