Footnotes

DESERT BAY was unhurried into stride, was forced wide through the turn when SIR VICAR came out, angled in leaving the bend, came four wide, split horses and wore down CASTLE STORM in the final yards. CASTLE STORM settled in hand, swung six wide to make a bold bid leaving the turn, forged command and kept on well but was unable to resist the winner. EDEN SINNER was allowed to settle, angled out five wide and was just up to earn the show. TWO COINS disputed the pace along the inside, had the jockey lose the whip inside the quarter pole and weakened during the drive. A J ROCKS broke slow, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. STORMY RODEO STAR contested the pace three wide, but faltered between horses entering the stretch and faded. SIR VICAR was close up four wide, drifted out further under left handed urging and was through after a half. BRESLAUER was through early. BANDICEK was outrun. GO FOR FOUR BUDDY contended briefly but stopped before going a half.
