## Footnotes

BABY BROWN EYES was unhurried into stride, circled five wide, wore down the leaders and edged clear late. ANGEL HOPE disputed the pace along the inside, kept on well through a prolonged drive but was unable to resist the winner. SHIRLEY SAYS SO was allowed to settle, advanced between horses, loomed a danger entering the stretch but was unable to bridge the gap. LATE was unprepared at the start, made a middle move five wide, loomed a danger but failed to sustain the drive. SYN NO MORE was forwardly placed along the inside, shifted out after a half, but flattened entering the stretch and faded. KELSEY DRIVE contested the pace two wide, but came up empty between horses after six furlongs and faded. FRENCH SUNRISE was outrun. RUBY FLAME showed little. KITTYBUS was through after a half.
