AZICHARMYOU sped clear to dictate terms, widened entering the stretch despite bearing out and maintained a safe advantage. SELDAN settled saving ground, got through to make his bid entering the lane but was unable to reach the winner. SKIM SCAM chased the pace three deep, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. WHISKEY TAP was forwardly placed four wide, loomed a danger nearing the quarter pole, was carried out further entering the stretch and faltered in the final furlong. LORD DUBAI was bumped at the start and allowed to settle, but lacked a response when called upon. GORDON angled in to save ground but was always outrun.
