QUEBEC CITY vied for the lead near the rail, raced off the inside on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch and held sway under pressure. FIRST MOVEMENT forced the pace four wide, moved out a path on the second turn, and was gaining late. GOLD BELLS SPIN prompted the pace early, raced four wide on the second turn and weakened in the drive. VODEL alternated for the lead from the start, raced in the three path on the second turn and tired. CITIZEN JOHN reserved five wide, moved out to the six path on the second turn and could not threaten. HOT SKY was no threat. PLEASE INCLUDE ME failed to menace.
