SHERIFF BULLOCK settled between horses, came three wide to make his bid, and wore down KITCHENMAN following a prolonged drive. KITCHENMAN opened clear to set the pace, fought on well through a long drive but grudgingly gave in. WORKINONTRAILROAD settled saving ground, got through and finished well to earn the show. YO COLTRANE was unhurried into stride, came three wide and improved position between horses. ASTAIRE was allowed to settle, came five wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. FOREST LORD was forwardly placed four wide to the stretch and faded. JACK IN THE PULPIT steadily retreated. CITIZEN JOHN showed little. HEY DREW was fractious in the gate, hopped at the start and was outrun.
