FOR FILLIES AND MARES, FOUR-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$200 to enter and \$200 additional to start. Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry Thursday, March 10, 2005 by payment of \$2,500 each (includes all fees). \$40,000 Guaranteed plus \$10,000 KTDF for KTDF eligibles only. Monies to be divided 62% to the owner of the winner, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Weight: 121 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over since November 30, allowed, 3 lbs.; \$25,000 twice at a mile or over in 2004-2005, 5 lbs.; \$21,000 at a mile or over since December 25, 7 lbs. Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve starters. Preference to start will be given in the following order: Graded/Group Stakes Winners (in order I-II-III). Stakes winners, then highest total earnings in 2004-2005.
