PERFECTLY THERESA vied for the early lead inside, was taken back a bit after a quarter, came again off the inside into the second turn, challenged with three furlongs to go, opened a clear lead near the sixteenth marker then held sway late. CLEARSOUL reserved along the inside, waited behind the leaders on the second turn, steadied in upper stretch wen lacked clear room, angled out inside the final furlong and finished well to miss. OBRIEN vied for the early lead outside the winner, took over from that one after a quarter, set the pace along the inside into the stretch, held on well to the final furlong and tired. VICE ORR VERSA outrun early three wide, made a solid middle move in the two path but gave way in the stretch. BEST TAKE reserved off the inside, was no threat. DEMON FEVER was no factor. MY MADELINE behind the leaders along the inside, faded. EMMY WINNER four wide early, was outrun.
