PUBLIC SPEAKER reserved for a half, moved up three wide with three furlongs to go, challenged approaching the stretch and proved best under pressure. ALPHABET MAGIC forwardly placed, waited behind rivals around the second turn and into the stretch, angled out just inside the final furlong and finished willingly. I'M WAITING FOR U outrun early, made a good middle move off the rail, angled out for the drive, challenged in mid stretch and held on gamely. EDIT THIS closest to the pace three wide, challenged before a half, gained a short lead on the second turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened. U D GHETTO set the pace off the inside, responded willingly when challenged before a half, held on well to the final furlong and tired. ITSALLBOUTTHECHASE was no threat. ROMNEY MARSH was outrun.
