KENTUCKY PEACHES settled in hand toward the inside, closed the gap between horses on the second turn, came three wide, caught the faltering TRIBECKY inside the sixteenth pole and edged clear late. TRIBECKY sped clear to set all of the pace, but shortened stride during the drive and was unable to resist the winner. SAILORS PASTTIME was allowed to settle, circled five wide and was making up ground. LEMON CRUNCH was hustled along four wide through a prolong drive but wasn't good enough. MUST BE GOLD contended along the inside to the stretch and faded. FINEST VISION showed little. IN THE FRAME was forwardly placed between horses to the second turn and dropped out. SYND was outrun.
