HOPEFUL PROSPECT, unhurried early, was angled out four wide leaving the turn when rallying and closed fast to be clear. TRICKLE DOWN, forwardly placed, raced four wide into the turn, challenged soon after, drew clear into the stretch but was no match for the winner late. ALLIE NORTH, never far back, challenged between rivals on the turn but gave way in the drive. BILLIE BUTTONS, unhurried early four wide, was fanned six wide entering the stretch but lodged only a mild late bid. QUILT, within striking distance off the inside, was angled out four wide late on the turn and tired. SALEM EMPRESS, unhurried early out in the strip, was fanned five wide late on the turn and was no threat. LA JOYA, forwardly placed inside, gave way the final quarter. DIXIE LADY was outrun in the three path. AMAZING MADELINE was no factor. RANBA sprinted clear, set the early pace inside but faded in the stretch.
