ROMANTIC COMEDY set a slow early pace while off the inside, repulsed a bid by TRACI GIRL on the second turn, drew clear into the stretch and held sway late. ENJOY THE JOURNEY unhurried early while off the inside, advanced in that path on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and closed well late. GO JEANAIE GO forwardly placed off the inside, moved out to be four wide on the second turn and lacked a late bid. WATER GAP reserved for a half, raced five wide on the second turn and rallied belatedly. TRACI GIRL within striking distance three wide, made a run at the winner on the second turn but tired in the final furlong. GRAND MODEL close up along the inside, faded.
