COULEE prompted the pace three deep, assumed command entering the stretch and widened through the drive. READY TO ROCK was allowed to settle into stride, rallied six wide and was just up to earn the place. BLUE DIABLO rushed to the fore from between horses, weakened during the drive and ended on even terms for the show. SERNA'S GOLD settled in hand, bid between horses five wide, loomed large but lacked the needed late response and halved the show spot. PARK AT DARK chased the pace four wide, but faltered from between horses entering the stretch and faded. MODEL'S MEMO showed little. BRINDLE BUG was through early.
