VICK'S VIOLET stalked the pace in hand, launched her bid three wide, assumed command entering the stretch and widened through the drive. TOCLOSETOTHEMUSIC was allowed to settle, came four wide to make her rally, finished well and was along for the place. SOUTHERN SWEET TEA was away alertly, disputed the pace along the inside, kicked clear through the turn, weakened during the drive and just failed to hold the place. IRISH VISION settled in the second flight, came four wide and improved her position. NEVAEH'S SONG was hustled along on the inside in mid pack and went evenly. STUDIO ONE broke in the air to get away behind her field, finished with a belated gain but was never a factor. IN BRISKERS CASE was hung wide throughout and showed little. FAXY DECOR broke slowly and was always outrun. THUNDERING JILL rushed to the lead two wide, but was hard used and stopped before going a half.
