BRINGINGDOWN BABEL pulled to contention along the inside, altered course leaving the turn, finished with a rush once clear and quickly drew clear. GRANNYS GREEN EYES settled in hand early, made a bold bid five wide, opened clear with a furlong to run but was no match for the winner late. SECRET FILE stalked the pace three deep, was carried out leaving the turn when BRINGINGDOWN BABEL veered out, kept on well and was making up ground late. OFFICERS GLORY broke slowly, made a belated gain seven wide but failed to threaten. BELLE MUSE angled out to be clear, was hustled along six wide and went evenly. BULL ALLEY was away alertly to set a clear pace, was collared midway through the turn, stayed on to the final furlong and faded. SMART REASON contended between horses to the stretch and retreated. CROSSWISE hopped at the start to get away slow and showed little thereafter.
