MARY REBECCA reserved off the rail, angled out five wide late on the second turn for clear room then closed fast to be clear. UNBRIDLED APPROVAL within striking distance, challenged three wide on the second turn and held on gamely in the drive. PARACLETE closest to the pace while off the inside, challenged on the second turn, took over in midstretch but weakened late. TIJUANA BRASS reserved along the inside, made a mild middle move to reach contention but had no late bid. DAISYAGO within striking distance between rivals, had nothing left late. ONE TOUGH CAT never far back along the inside, split rivals entering the stretch but weakened in the drive. DARING DIVA close up from the outset, raced three wide on the second turn and tired. ALICE ROSE sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside and tired in the stretch. GOLDEN VIEW in hand early, steadily dropped back.
