PRESENTS FOR BERTI closed up three wide, challenged on the second turn, took over once in the stretch and drew off under steady urging. BERLIOZ set the pace off the inside, was no match for the winner but prevailed for the place. BUDGE MAN outrun for a half, came four wide out of the second turn and improved his position while no threat. VINTAGE DAVE within striking distance off the inside, lacked a late bid. MONASHEE GOLD (IRE) forced the pace off the inside and tired. MACCARIB PASS was no factor.
