Footnotes

GALLOPING VICTOR was well placed in mid pack, rallied into the stretch and drew clear, drifted out and was all out to just last late. TEDS BUDDY was taken up entering the first turn, angled out on the backstretch and rallied seven wide on the far turn and lost ground and was gaining late and while probably best. ALLEY ANTHEM set the pace while off the rail, had a clear lead on the second turn, ran evenly late and had no closing response. BLUES CROSSING stalked the pace while never far back on the outside, ran evenly throughout and had no rally. BOLD STORM RISING was unhurried early, improved position but was never a threat to the winner. NOBLE INTENT was void of early speed, rallied on the far turn, failed to sustain the bid and ran evenly late. BORDEN BRAVE bore in entering the first turn and bothered foes, flashed good early speed, gave way and dropped back. SUERTE SKY was no factor. ZINEDINE flashed before stopping, was eased.
