BEAUCHAMP VICEROY (GB) opened clear and angled in to dictate terms, turned back the bid SWINGING BERNIE inside the furlong marker and widened late. SWINGING BERNIE attended the pace toward the inside, shifted out three wide to make a bold bid but was unable to match strides with the winner. MR. WATT was allowed to settle, came four wide and was just up to earn the show. SILVERDADDYOFMINE settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. MAJOR KEENE was forwardly placed three wide through the second turn and faded. BELLEOFTHEVALLEY settled saving ground, had the jockey lose the whip leaving the second turn and failed to menace. HUMBLE EARL broke slow and was never a factor. The jockey of HUMBLE EARL lodged an objection against SWINGING BERNIE for alleged interference leaving the gate, but following the Stewards review there was no change to the order of finish.
