Footnotes

RATATAT asked early to race within striking distance, drifted seven leaving the turn then finished well to be clear late. MICHAELS PARK behind the leaders, moved up three wide midway through the turn, challenged with a furlong to go and held on for the place. STORMIN LARRY set the pace along the inside and weakened late. PRIDEOFTHECHAPTER outrun early, came four wide out of the turn and lacked the needed closing bid. MOUNT RAZMORE within striking distance along the inside, lodged a mild late bid. SOULADAR forced the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. MUTAKDDIM'S CROWN was outrun. DERBYVILLE SPECIAL seven wide late on the turn, could not menace.
