MACEVIL stalked the pace, launched his bid four wide, opened clear and held safely. BO'S SHEPARD was pinched back at the start, made a long drive circling six wide, finished well but was unable to bridge the gap. POLARIS prompted the pace along the inside, weakened during the drive but had enough left to hold the show. C J MON was pinched back at the start and unhurried into stride, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. FENWAY SLUGGER was forwardly placed along the inside, shifted out leaving the turn but lacked a response when called upon. FINE LEATHER set the pressured pace three wide, but came up empty between horses leaving the turn and faded. CONTRAPUNTAL showed little. LITTLE J J was through early.
