GATOR CAMP disputed the pace along the inside, fought on through a prolonged drive and gamely edged clear late. CHEERS FOR WICKED prompted the pace three wide, kept on well through a long drive but was unable to match strides with the winner in the final yards. LARRY AND ELAINE contended off of the inside, angled out entering the stretch and was all out to earn the show. HAM I AM settled saving ground, shifted out entering the stretch and improved position. PRAYEROFAWARRIOR set the pressured pace between horses, contested the issue to the final furlong and faltered. SWEETSOUTHERNPITCH pulled between horses, but flattened leaving the second turn and failed to threaten. JABBAWOKEE was close up four wide to the second turn and tired. THE DREAM OF PAUL was through early, dropped well back and was distanced through the stretch.
