IRONIC LADY vied for the lead off the inside and drew off in the drive under steady handling. MULLIGAN'S DANCE, unhurried early, raced five wide on the turn and lodged only a mild bid for the place. MARY CAHILL'S RIB, forwardly placed, raced in the three path on the turn and tired in the drive. IF YOU TWO, outrun early off the inside, was no factor. REGENY ROAD, rank at the start, was outrun early, raced six wide on the turn and was no factor. KISSTHEBOYSGOODBYE, reserved early, was three wide on the turn and could not menace. PLUVIAL, in tight near the half mile marker, was angled out, moved four wide into the turn and faded the final quarter. BLADE OF HONOR drifted in on the backstretch placing two rivals in tight when vying for the lead, gained the inside on the turn but faded in the drive. SAN ANTONIO ROSE, in tight near the half mile pole, faded inside.
