GOLD BY DESIGN pressed leader from the rail, angled out around the turn and drew off under a steady drive. NICKI'S WISH never far back, behind wall of horses to the turn, angled out and rallied for place through the final furlong. IRISH VISION good speed from the outset, held well to deep stretch but weakened in the late going. INDIAN FIRE angled out to make a bid four wide at the quarter pole but flattened out in the drive. TO ORDER off slow, went up five into the turn but could not sustain her bid in the stretch run. MY NAME'S JEMIMA vied from three wide early but gave way. APPEALINGTEMPTING was never a threat. JUDY'S GEM was through early. FRISKY MOOD had a steady fade.
