RANSOM THE KITTEN was allowed to settle, advanced into striking distance four wide, drew even with a quarter to run and gradually edged clear. MY TWO ROSES vied for the lead along the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner but stayed on well to hold the place. LUZ DEL NORTE was allowed to settle, made a late rally circling six wide and was along for the show. LADY TOCCET pressed the pace between horses to the stretch and weakened. ALL TOO IMPRESSIVE saved ground to some avail. PLAY US OUT was slow into stride, made a belated gain along the inside but was never a factor. ZEND NERAH was allowed to settle three wide and failed to respond. JOZI'S SONG disputed the pace three wide, was collared between horses leaving the second turn and stopped.
