MOCHA JOE was unhurried into stride, advanced five wide, reeled in the leader inside the furlong marker and edged clear late. GHOST CHAPEL opened clear to set all of the pace, was unable to resist the winner but continued on well to clearly prove second best. TALK IT OUT was slow into stride, angled in to save ground, got through to make a late rally and was just up to earn the show. ARCH ENEMY ONE was allowed to settle, made a mild rally four wide but failed to seriously threaten. GREAT RISK was forwardly placed three wide, made a middle move to range into striking distance, but came up empty after six furlongs and dropped out. DREAM ONLY OF ME chased the pace off of the inside, but faltered leaving the second turn and retreated. DRAKE MANOR dropped far back, trailed throughout and was distanced through the lane.
