DONT POKE THE BEAR within striking distance, moved up five wide on the second turn and wore down the leader. GENESIS ONE vied for the lead off the inside and held on gamely to miss. JUSTAMATTEROFTIME behind the leaders, raced in the four path on the second turn and tired in the drive. SARKOZY within reach early, moved out to be six wide with three furlongs to go and could not threaten. VAGUELY A SAINT was no factor. STAGE SUCCESS alternated for the lead three wide and faded.
