BURKE'S SISTER pressed the pace early, angled off the rail entering the lane then took over the lead in the stretch and drew clear late but held in the final stages. THIS WAY HOME was well placed early, angled into the three path in the far turn then rallied in the stretch but missed late. HILLY M set the pace early while dueling from the inside, stayed on the rail in the far turn then faltered late in the stretch drive. BELLAFINA tracked the pace early from the outside, angled into the three path entering the lane with no late bid in the stretch. LA ROCKETTE angled into the three path in the far turn while no threat. CRIMSON DOON was unhurried early while making a bid into the turn but faded late in the drive.
