**Footnotes**

BODAZZLE stalked the pace early, angled into the four path inside the quarter pole with a long drive in the stretch and edged clear late under a steady drive. KENTUCKY PEACHES set the pace early, angled off the rail into the far turn and faltered late in the stretch run. SWEET EUPHORIA chased the pace early while on the inside in the far turn then flattened out in the stretch drive. DANCING LYDIA was well placed early, angled into the five path inside the quarter pole and couldn't sustain the bid late. CHILE TEQUILA tracked the pace early, angled into the three path inside the quarter pole and faded late. KISSIN BOBBY VICAR was never a threat.
