GREELEY'S GOLD set the pace early, angled off the rail in the turn then drew clear in the stretch but just lasted at the wire. SANDESTIN was well placed early, angled into the four path inside the quarter pole then rallied in the stretch quickly and just missed at the wire. SWEET STRAWBERRY stalked the pace early, angled into the three path inside the quarter pole but did not have enough late. FLYING CHANCE angled into the five path inside the quarter pole and moved up in the stretch. PERFECT SAND angled into the four path in the turn while no threat late. SNUFF was never a factor. HOWDY BOY RIB had brief speed then retreated. DIAMONDS ARE IN raced up close early then was getting out throughout the turn and eventually folded up in the stretch.
