INDIAN HUNTER was allowed to settle, closed the gap three deep, split rivals a furlong out and inched away under stern left handed pressure. MR BIG SHOT settled in hand, circled five wide, finished well but was unable to match strides late. BEHRENS SHADOW made a long drive four wide, opened clear entering the stretch, but flattened in the drive and settled for the minor award. MR. WHAT'S THAT settled saving ground, angled out and finished with a mild rally. CHEROKEE AXE made a middle move between rivals three wide, poked his head in front briefly but failed to sustain the drive. DURING DANCER E F was fractious in the gate, broke slow and passed only the tiring ones. BOBBY T failed to respond. CARSON'S VENTURE pressed the pace along the inside through the turn and tired. THE RAG MAN set the pressured pace between horses for a a half and stopped.
