Footnotes

MAMBOO angled in entering the turn after being carried out late on the backstretch, raced within striking distance three wide, challenged with a furlong to go and proved narrowly best. CHAPELLA carried out on the backstretch, raced seven wide on the turn when prominent, challenged with a furlong to go but was outfinished. REASON TO MEDAL ran off a quarter mile after entering the track in the post parade, rushed to the lead, drifted out in the run down the backstretch, raced in the five path on the turn, held on well to inside the final furlong and faltered. CANDICE B LOVE carried out on the backstretch while close up, raced six wide on the turn, challenged in midstretch but weakened. ARGUE within striking distance, was carried out seven wide near the three furlong marker then lacked a late bid. ARWEN UNDOMIEL close up early, drifted out near the three furlong marker carrying ARGUE out then tired. PROUD INDIAN outrun for a half, was no threat. THUNDERING MARIA was no factor. ITALIAN MUSIC carried out on the backstretch when forwardly placed, angled in entering the turn and faded after a half.
