MARATHON MOON stalked the pace three wide, came four wide to make a bold bid, forged a clear lead nearing the furlong marker and held a diminishing advantage. WAKES WEEK settled in hand, circled five wide to make his bid, finished well but was unable to reach the winner. MAMBO'S BRIDGE sped clear to set the pace, was collared entering the stretch, weakened once headed but had enough left to hold the show. PRONTISSIMO was unhurried into stride, made a mild rally seven wide but failed to threaten. POWER PARTS rushed to contention toward the inside, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. KENTUCKY PRESENT saved ground to no avail.
