GO GETEM outrun early, advanced six wide on the turn and closed well to be up in time. POT OF GOLD reserved early, raced in the five path on the turn, made a good move after a half, gained a short lead in midstretch but missed. FRENCHMAN'S COVE closest to the pace four wide, challenged on the turn, battled into the final furlong and held on gamely. ITS MR. CAT TO YOU forced back at the start, angled out, made a five wide move on the turn but tired in the drive. BLACK CROW set the pace three wide, held on well to midstretch and tired. KESAGAMI ducked out at the start and bumped ITS MR. CAT TO YOU, raced within reach along the inside but had nothing left in the drive. ARABIAN CHEETAH forwardly placed from the start, raced in traffic after three furlongs, steadied approaching the stretch and tired. WILD ALEX close up while off the inside, faded.
