Footnotes

HOT CHA CHA was back early, angled into the four path inside the quarter pole while circling the field then drove past the leaders in the stretch and drew off late under a steady drive. FITZ JUST RIGHT dueled early from between horses, angled into the three path entering the late then battled down the stretch to get up for place late while no match for the winner. INSTRUMENTALIST dueled early from the inside, angled off the rail into the far turn then faltered late in the stretch drive. WALLOON raced up close early while on the inside entering the lane but weakened late in the drive. STONE LEGACY was far back early, angled into the five path inside the quarter pole and improved position late in the stretch run. SUPER PONI angled off the rail into the far turn while no factor late. OCULUNA tracked the pace early, angled into the four path entering the lane and faded late in the drive. HONCHIS'N PONCHIS angled into the three path inside the quarter pole and never menaced. FOXY BAILEY vied for the lead early, swung into the six path into the turn and soon retreated. STEP OUT SMARTLY was never a threat.
