

Footnotes

NEW YORK HERO pressed the early pace from the three path, challenged after a half, gained a short lead in upper stretch, responded willingly when challenged by EUGENE'S THIRD SON in midstretch and outfinished that one while drifting out steadily the final sixteenth. EUGENE'S THIRD SON within striking distance from the start three wide, advanced four wide into the stretch, challenged with a furlong to go and could not quite get to NEW YORK HERO while carried out by that one in the final sixteenth. CHAMPALI stumbled at the start, recovered to be close up, saved ground on the second turn and into the stretch, challenged inside the top pair with a furlong to go but weakened. LION TAMER outsprinted early, moved to within striking distance four wide on the first turn, moved in a bit around the second turn, angled out in upper stretch but hung. SAINTLY LOOK vied for the lead along the inside, came off the rail after a half, held on well to midstretch and tired. LOTS OF SIZZLE reserved along the inside, tired. CHICKEN SOUP KID five wide on the first turn when within striking distance, moved in to the four path on the second turn and faded in the final quarter. WENDLAR outrun early, was no factor. OZZIE CAT recovered awkwardly when bumped after the start, raced within striking distance early three wide and gave way.
