Footnotes

BLACK ONYX tracked five wide, moved up to join the vanguard with three furlongs to run, struck the front entering the stretch, shook off TAKEN BY THE STORM inside the furlong marker and edged clear. UNCAPTURED attended the pace in hand off of the inside, shifted out entering the stretch, continued on well but was unable to bridge the gap. GIANT FINISH prompted the pace three wide, was unable to match strides with the winner through the drive but stayed on to earn the show. TAKEN BY THE STORM stalked the leader four wide, forged command after six furlongs, edged clear briefly on the second turn, was collared near the five-sixteenths pole, contested the issue to the final furlong and weakened. FEAR THE KITTEN contended toward the inside, advanced between horses through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch and was making up ground. FOR GREATER GLORY was unhurried into stride, rallied circling five wide and improved position. CHANNEL ISLE settled saving ground, got through entering the stretch but lacked a response when called upon. MY NAME IS MICHAEL settled between horses while never far back, but had little for the drive when put to pressure. CAPO BASTONE stumbled at the start to get away behind his field and was never a factor. GENERAL ELECTION failed to respond. BALANCE THE BOOKS was unhurried between horses, moved up with a mild bid on the second turn but came up empty entering the stretch. MAC THE MAN was away alertly to set the pressured pace, was collared nearing the three-eighths pole, stopped once headed, was eased to the wire but walked off.
