

Footnotes

BALTO STAR sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside while lightly rated, repulsed several bids by MONGOOSE late on the backstretch, responded to steady left handed pressure in upper stretch and rapidly drew off in the stretch. HALO'S STRIDE never far back while off the inside, improved his position on the second turn, reached closest to the winner with a furlong to go, was no threat to that one while best of the others. MONGOOSE forwardly placed early three wide, made several runs at the winner after a half but tired in the final quarter. CAMDEN PARK bobbled at the start, recovered to race within striking distance four wide, improved his position three wide after six furlongs but tired. FAN CLUB'S MISTER away alertly, was a bit rank when in tight and restrained along the inside approaching the first turn when forwardly placed, dropped well back to be outrun thereafter and was not a threat. BUCKLE DOWN BEN forwardly placed three wide, kept pace with the leaders in that path for six furlongs and tired in the drive. MEETYOUATHEBRIG five wide on the first turn when within striking distance, moved closer before a half, raced four wide with three furlongs to go and faded. KEATS stumbled at the start, pulled his way to a forward position in the initial furlong, steadied behind the winner entering the first turn, steadied again late on that turn when in tight, dropped back, angled out five wide after six furlongs and was no factor. CLUTCH PLAYER within striking distance off the inside, stopped and was eased.
