ROYAL CUP set the pace off the inside and stayed clear under steady urging. YASOW KERRI forwardly placed four wide, lacked the needed closing bid. QUICK ADVICE reserved early, raced in the four path on the turn and was no real threat. PYRAMYST lost her footing at the start, recovered to race within striking distance off the rail but tired. IMPERIAL GRACE never far back along the inside, faded. WISE AFFAIR closest to the early pace in the three path, faded.
