

SEALY HILL within striking distance three wide, moved up quickly four wide on the second turn, challenged approaching the stretch, drew clear then lasted late. PANTY RAID broke thru the starting gate prior to the start and ran off a short distance, she raced forwardly off the inside, angled out a bit for the drive and rallied willingly to miss. ASPIRING within striking distance, five wide, advanced four wide on the second turn, reached closest to the winner in upper stretch but hung. OUR DANCING BABE far back early, raced seven wide into the second turn, made a bold move to the quarter mile marker but tired in the drive. SILVERINYOURPOCKET dropped back five wide on the first turn, made a mild move off the inside on the second turn but had no late bid. INDIAN WAR DRESS reserved off the inside, was no threat. BAVARIAN BELLE within striking distance near the rail, tired. OLIVINE outrun early, raced six wide into the second turn and could not menace. ACADIA BREEZE broke through the starting gate prior to the start, sprinted clear, set the pace along the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. RIVANNA RIVER was no factor. TALE OF THE QUEEN prominent for a half four wide, faded. FLORAL PARK closest to the pace for a half, stopped badly.
