TELLALITTLESECRET stalked the pace three wide, reeled in the leader on the second turn, shook clear entering the stretch and held safely. JOYOUS VICTORY was unhurried into stride, circled five wide to make her bid but was unable to reach the winner. SLICK MISS fought restraint and was hung wide through the first turn, made a middle move five wide, but flattened during the drive and gave way. HEARTS DON'T LIE settled in hand toward the inside, got through entering the stretch to make a mild bid but lacked the needed late response. GO GET LOST was rank to place along the inside, pulled to the lead leaving the first turn, opened clear before going a half, was collared after six furlongs and gave way readily once headed. WALK ON settled between horses under a hard hold but lacked a response when called upon. BURL'S JUNIANA contended off of the inside for a half and dropped out.
