Footnotes

PALLASO disputed the pace between horses, edged clear nearing the quarter pole and held safely through the drive. FLETCHER tracked the pace three wide, offered a mild bid but was unable to reach the winner. TUFFER was unhurried into stride, angled out entering the stretch, finished with a late rally and was along for the show. SNOWGRATS contended four wide to the stretch and faded. SIR VICAR settled six wide, drifted out further through the turn and was never a factor. BRESLAUER hopped at the start and showed little thereafter. PAIN GIVER vied for the lead along the inside for a half and stopped.
