Footnotes

SWIFT WARRIOR set the pressured pace between horses, opened clear before going a half, widened the advantage into the stretch and held safely. CRIMSON CHINA broke slowly and was unhurried into stride, made a sweeping move circling five wide, finished full of run but was left with too much to do. THE OLE GEN vied four wide between horses, bumped repeatedly with SWAGGER JACK from the quarter pole to the furlong marker, weakened thereafter and settled for the show. SWAGGER JACK broke slow, rushed to contention five wide, bumped repeatedly with THE OLD GEN leaving the second turn to mid stretch and flattened out. OCASTA was forwardly placed between horses for six furlongs and faded. SORGHO bobbed at the start, was allowed to settle in the second flight and failed to respond. ST. IVAN was close up along the inside for a half and retreated. DISFRAZ made a middle move four wide, offered a mild bid with five-sixteenths to run, but failed to sustain the drive. GRANDPA GIBBY was through early.
