YANKEE VICTOR, bumped at the start, raced within striking distance four wide, challenged with three furlongs to go and edged off late under pressure. BLACK MERCURY lost his footing at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, moved up five wide with three furlongs to go and finished willingly to be second best while not able to stay with the winner late. PERSHING, closest to the pace in the three path, challenged before a half, gained a short lead on the second turn but tired the final furlong. DAVEY'S CUTLASS broke slow, was reserved early off the inside, moved closer on the backstretch but tired in the drive. INDIKY sprinted clear, set the pace off the inside but faded the final quarter. TORCH MAJIC, bumped at the start, was forwardly placed inside but stopped.
